

WELCOME to the first edition of our newsletter. This newsletter will be given out each term to let everyone know of all the amazing things the Eco Team are working on.




THE ECO DISPLAY can be found in the main hall. You can always find what the Eco Committee are working on and who's on the Eco Committee.
