## **Pupil Premium and Free School Meals Explained**

Dear Parents/Carers,

If your child is eligible for free school meals, we would like to encourage you to register them.

Children in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 get free school meals anyway through a different scheme. However, if they are eligible for free school meals when they join us in Year 3, we still really want you to register – see why below.

### **Why register for free school meals?**

Children who are registered for free school meals don't have to eat them if you prefer them to have packed lunches.

But registering them is still important because, for every child registered for free school meals, the school gets an extra £1,480 through 'Pupil Premium' funding.

Every child registered for free school meals makes a big difference to the school.

### **Is my child eligible for free school meals?**

If you receive these benefits, your child may be eligible:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance or Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (as long as you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit) if you have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on - but not if you receive Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit, if your earned income after tax is £616.67 per month (£7,400 per year) or less.

To complete a check you will need to provide the following information:

- Name, home address and email address
- National Insurance Number or National Asylum Support Service reference number
- Child or student's name, date of birth and school

### **How do I register my child for free school meals?**

To register for free school meals, you can use the Hampshire County Council website at: <https://www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/hants/>

If you do not have access to the internet, or you would like the school to support you with the application check, please contact a member of the school office.

Please note – you do not need to reply if your son or daughter is already in receipt of Pupil Premium.

We strongly encourage all eligible parents/carers to apply for this status. No one will know who has registered and it will not affect any other benefits being claimed. Any children who are entitled to free schools meals, whether they take them up or not, means that our school is given extra funding to help support their needs. We realise that information of this nature is very sensitive and we can assure you that all such information will be treated in the strictest confidence.
