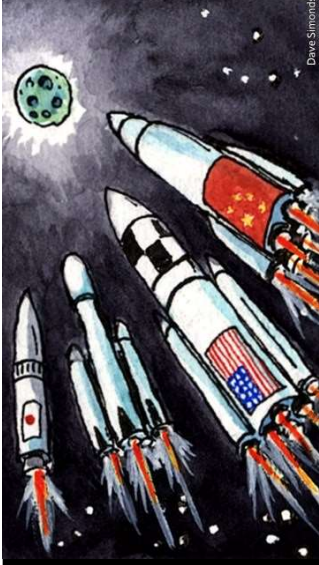


Year 4 - Spring 1

Main Focus

The topic this term will focus upon:

English: where the children will write a non-chronological report about The Nowhere Emporium.

Art: where the children will design their own imaginary 'wonder' and create it with collage.

Computing: where the children will learn how to use Google Slides in order to create a presentation linked to their writing from English. They will record themselves speaking on each slide.

Science: where the children will learn about sound, pitch and volume.

PSHE (not linked to the topic): where the children will learn about communities.

RE (not linked to the topic): exploring rituals.

Learning Experiences

- **English:** being immersed in a rich and inspiring text, exploring character's personalities and feelings, hot seating, writing in role, describing settings, describing characters, role play, writing in non-fictional styles.
- **Science:** using instruments to explore how sound is created, learning about pitch and volume, investigating how sound can be changed.
- **Computing:** using Google Slides and its features, recording themselves.
- **Art:** changing everyday items into surreal art, practising the techniques used for collage, creating a collage.
- **PSHE** (not linked to topic): exploring the concept of community and those groups in society that make up communities.
- **RE** (not linked to topic): exploring how food is used in rituals.
